Clothing Drive for the Teen & Kid Closet
All During November 2024
New or Gently Used Clean Clothing



During last Sunday's Service, we heard from a representative of Teen & Kid Closet. We are starting a clothing drive for them. She said right now they are short on baby clothing and clothing for teenagers, some of whom wear adult sizes. Also, they need winter gloves, hats, socks, etc.

They give new or gently used clothing to children who need it - free at a "store" where the kids can shop and try on clothes. Their focus is youth in foster care or in poverty. Most of the youth they serve have no other access to nice clothes. They serve kids from 0 - 13 years of age. If they receive clothing that they cannot use, they give them to other non-profits who can use them.
